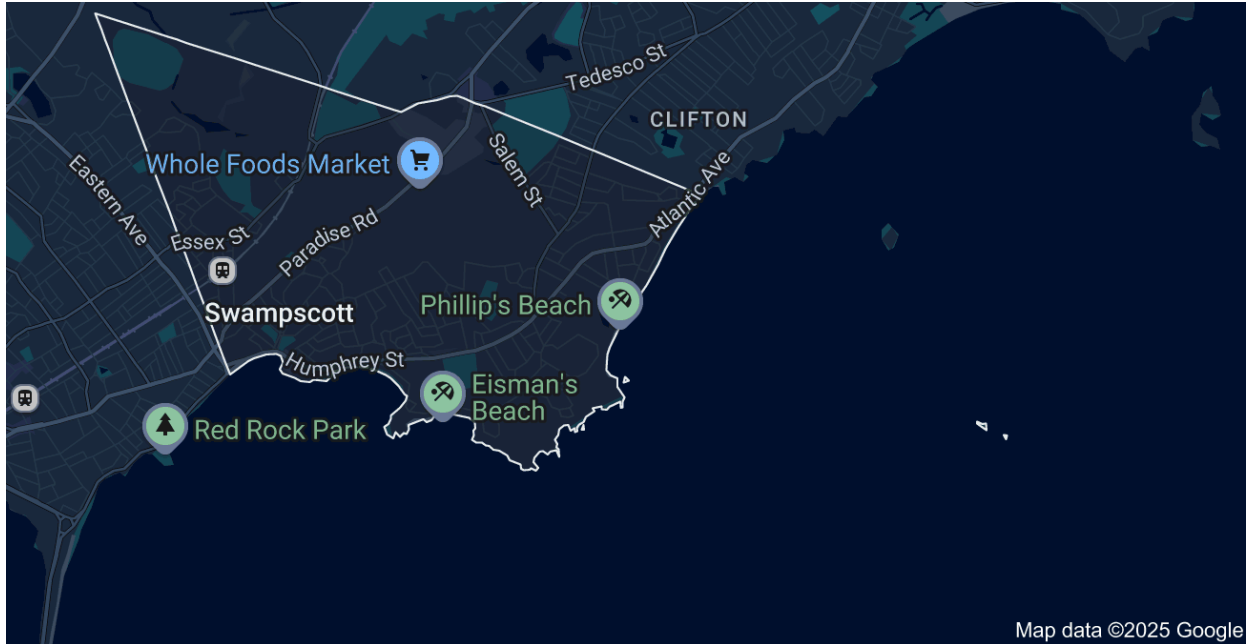

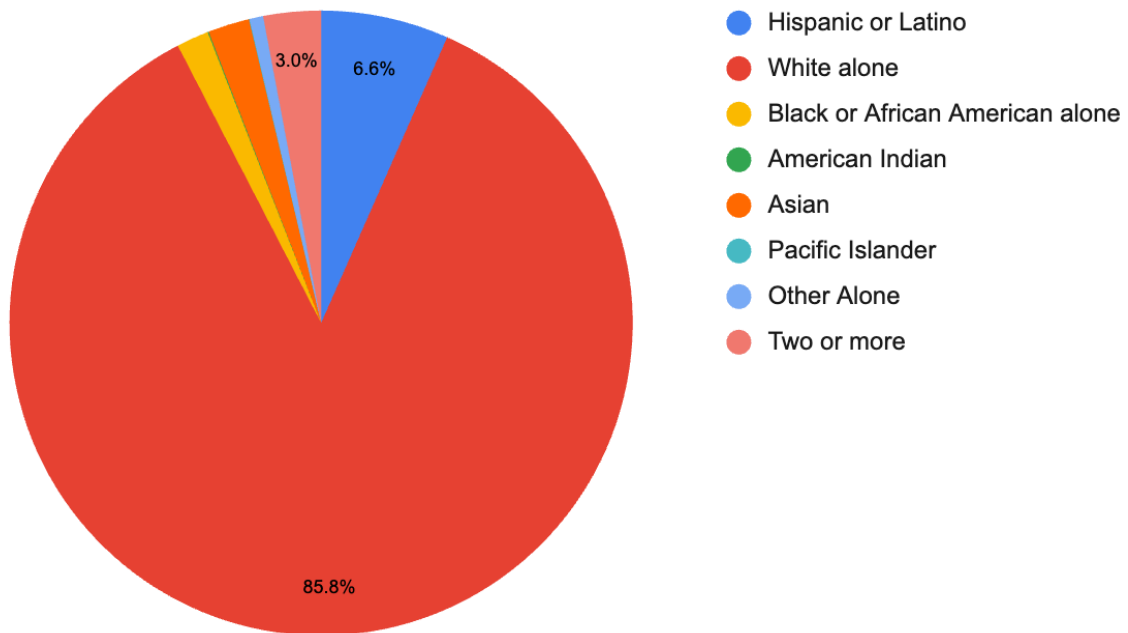

Demographic Breakdown

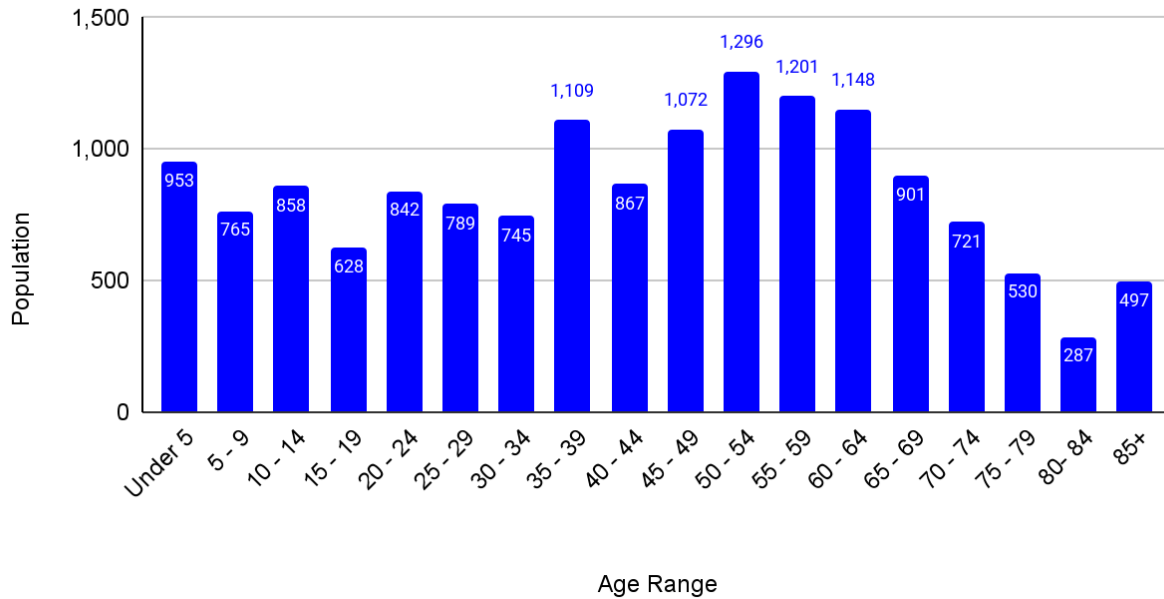
Demographics include race and ethnicity, age, sex, and language spoken. Understanding these characteristics will allow us to better serve our communities.

Swampscott by Race



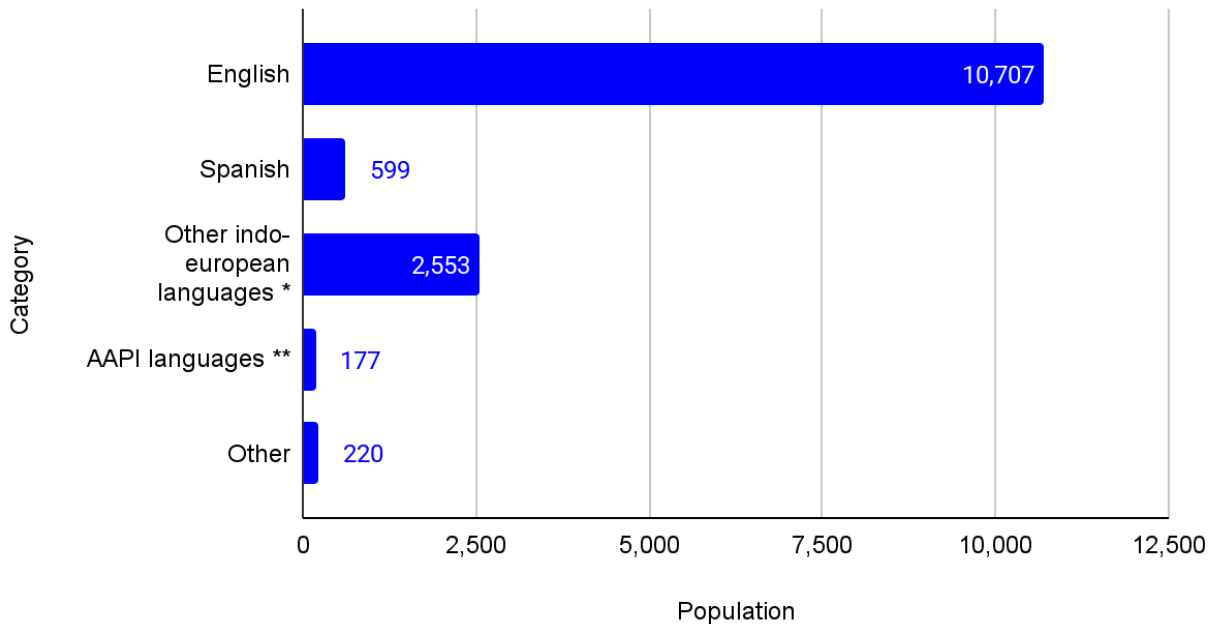
The racial and ethnic makeup of Swampscott consists of 85.8% of the population that identifies as non-Hispanic white, 6.6% as Hispanic/Latino, 3.0% as two or more races, 2.1% as Asian, 1.7% as Black or African American, 0.7% as other, 0.05% as American Indian, and 0.05% as Pacific Islander.

Swampscott Population by Age



The median age of a Swampscott resident is 45.3 and the largest sections of the population fall between 50-54 with 1,296 and 55-59 with 1,201. This follows a normal distribution

Swampscott Population Language Spoken at Home



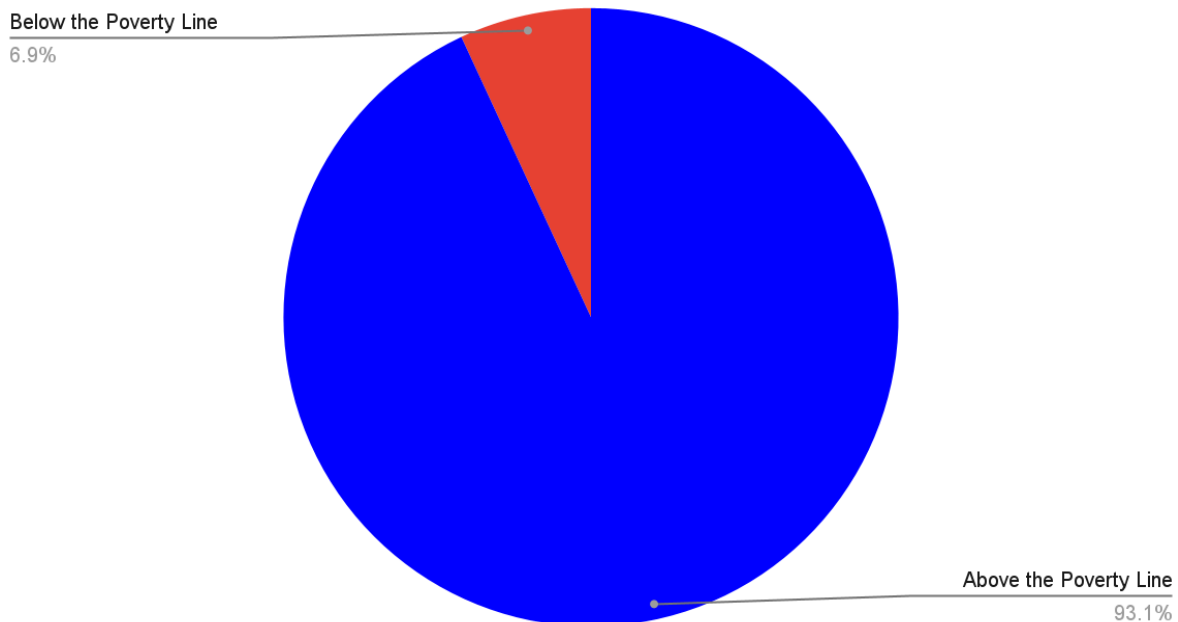

Social and Economic Breakdown

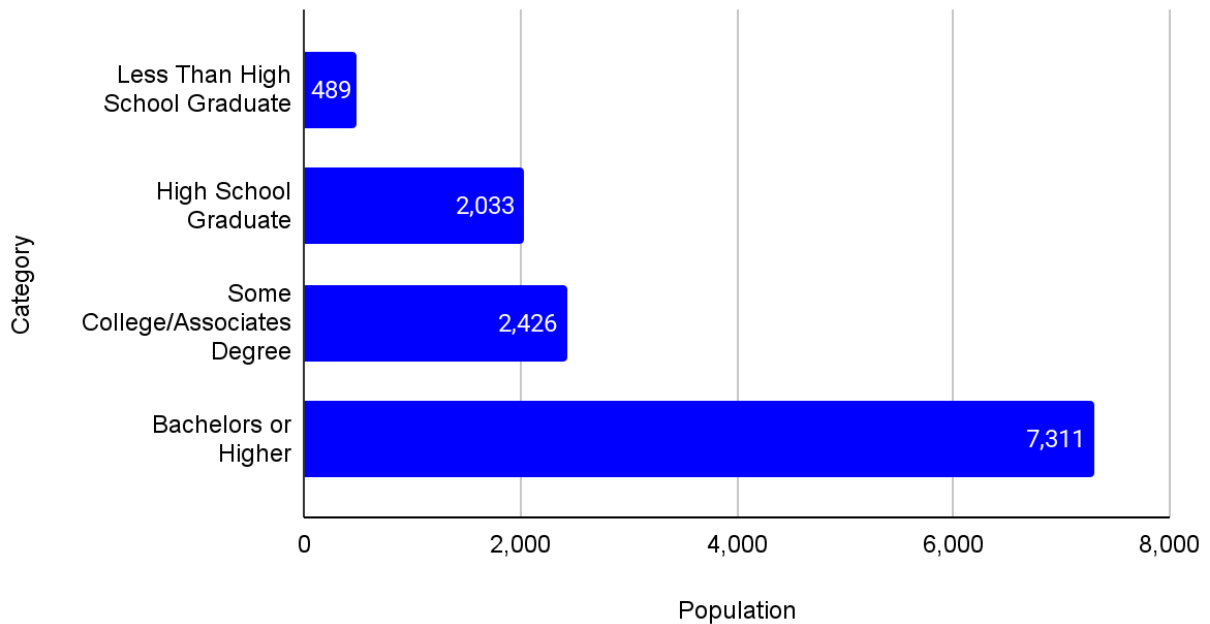

Swampscott by Poverty Status



6.9% of Swampscott residents live at or below the poverty line which is lower than the state's average of 10.4%.

Swampscott Population by Education Status



4,948 Swampscott residents above the age of 18 do not have a college degree, while 7,311 have received a bachelor's degree or a higher level of education.
